"FOR CONSPICUOUS GALLANTRY AND INTREPIDITY IN ACTION AGAINST THE ENEMY ON IWO JIMA, VOLCANO ISLANDS, ON 28 FEBRUARY, 1945. SERVING AS A COMPANY CORPSMAN, PHARMACIST'S MATE THIRD CLASS MARSH SAVED THE LIVES OF SEVERAL OF HIS COMRADES. WHEN THE PLATOON OF WHICH HE WAS A MEMBER WAS PINNED DOWN BY HEAVY SNIPER, MORTAR AND MACHINE GUN FIRE, PHARMACIST'S MATE THIRD CLASS MARSH, WITH COMPLETE DISREGARD FOR HIS OWN PERSONAL SAFETY, MOVED

FORWARD AND ADMINISTERED FIRST AID TO ALL WOUNDED AND THEN MOVED THEM BACK TO SAFETY. NOTICING THAT THE PLATOON ADJACENT TO HIS HAD SEVERAL CASUALTIES, HE MOVED THROUGH THE HEAVY FIRE AND ADMINISTERED FIRST AID TO THEM AS WELL. HIS CONSTANT BRAVERY AND WILLINGNESS TO SACRIFICE HIMSELF AT ALL TIMES WERE A SOURCE OF INSPIRATION AND MORALE TO HIS FELLOW MEN. HIS CONDUCT WAS IN KEEPING WITH THE HIGHEST TRADITIONS OF THE UNITED STATES NAVAL SERVICE."
